IREM® Tulsa Chapter 10 Scholarship Program

Stipulation and Benefits

An IREM Tulsa Chapter 10 Scholarship provides tuition up to \$800 for a recipient to attend an IREM course in any delivery mode—classroom, home study, or online. The scholarship may be used for tuition only. The scholarship does not cover the cost of fees or dues. Recipients may reapply for additional scholarship funding if needed, yearly. The funds must be used within 12 months of the recipient scholarship award.

Selection Criteria

The selection of recipients is based on, but not limited to these factors:

- Be a CPM Candidate and be current with annual national and chapter dues.
- Strength of letter of support from former and/or current employer(s).
- Demonstrated commitment to real estate management as evidenced by employment in the industry.

Required Documentation

To assure completeness of an application, the following items are needed:

- Scholarship application, including the signed employer letter of recommendation.
- Current resume.
- Personal statement of need. The written statement should address financial need, interest and commitment to real estate management as a career, and accomplishments that support the application.
